presents do grant unto Josh Pollett (free Colored Man) of Worcester County and State aforesaid
all that lot or parcel of land situated in Worcester County aforesaid being part of a tract
of land called Morris Inclusion and more particularly described as follows Beginning
at a point two and one quarter poles on the seventeenth line of the aforesaid tract of land
thence by & with said line reversed North forty four degrees & thirty minutes east sev-
enty six and one quarter perches thence North thirty five degrees west Eighteen perches
thence North one degree thirty minutes west six & three quarter perches
to an old cart road thence by & with said road North thirty six degrees & thirty minutes
