Item the 1<sup>st</sup> I give to my daughter Millie one acre  
of Land called Noblesse to her and her heirs  
forever

Item the 2<sup>nd</sup> I give to my daughter Ann one acre  
of Land called Noblesse to her and her heirs forever

Item the 3<sup>rd</sup> I give to my two Sons Stephen and  
~~Isaac~~ and Isaac I sell the rest of My Land  
Where I have her the amount is 30/- I give  
called Noblesse to them and their heirs for-  
ever by them paying to my daughter Maria  
and the sum of forty dollars

Item the 4<sup>th</sup> I leave My Hous on the farm for  
the use of the two boys Stephen and Isaac

I then I divine and bequeath all of the Rest of my  
Estate both Real and Personal To be Equally  
Divided between My 2 Sons and My 2 dear daughters  
Milsey and Mariah and Ann Pollitt To them and  
their heirs forever)

and I art by I Doe hereby Constitute and And  
Appoint Mr John C. Nolent to be sole Executor  
of this My last will and Testament Newkirk and  
Annulling ~~After to be and~~ some other all former  
Wills by Me hereto made Ratifying and Con-  
=ferring this and some other to be my last will  
and testament
